1. MADE TO REIGN.

Rev 3:10

- God has made you to reign here on earth, not when you get to heaven and God cannot lie.
 - **Num 23:19**
 - **1 Sam 15:29**
 - **Titus 1:2**
- By law of first mention in Genesis chapter 1, bible tells us that God made man in his own image.
 - **Gen 1:26-27**
- That means you have the life of God, the Zoe kind of life, the eternal life.
- If you've given your life to Christ, you already have eternal life.
- You are not only made in His image but also in His likeness, meaning you function like God.
- So how does God function?
 - **Gen 1:1-3**
- He creates.
- God exercises dominion, He takes charge.
- God said let there be light and light expelled darkness.
- That is how to reign.
- You don't fold your hands and watch the devil run roughshod over you while you are busy calling on God.
- You have no right to call on God while you are around.
- You are His representative.
 - **2 Cor 5:20**

- You can't claim you don't like him; he has already given birth to you and his seed is in you.

- **1 John 3:9**

- In July 22, 2013, something happened in the British monarchy.
- A son was born to Prince William.
- They gave him a name: His Royal Highness Prince George Alexander Lewis the Duke of Cambridge.
- Though the boy doesn't know his left from his right, he is the third in line to the throne.
- He is a royal highness and all the paraphernalia of office to ensure he lives up to the position is being put in place.
- He became that simply because he was born.
- The entire British government submits to him by virtue of being born.
- It is the same with you as a child of God.
- You are born into the kingdom of God.

- You are born into royalty.

- The reason the devil runs roughshod over you is because you have refused to behave like royalty.
 - **Gal 4:1**
- As the royal prince grows up, there are places he won't go, there are languages he won't speak and there are ways he won't dress.
- There are environments you won't find him in, there are foods he won't eat and movies he won't watch and companies he won't keep because of who he is.
 - **1 John 3:2-3**
- Don't reduce yourself to a common man when God has elevated you.
- God has made you uncommon, don't make yourself common.

 - **Ish 50:7**
 - **1 Cor 9:24-27**
- Obama's father only dropped him in America and in the midst of challenges, lack, depravity and allurements of sin in America; he made it to the throne.
- If they found anything indicting in his C.V. he would never have become president.

- It took a deliberate preparation.
- Child of God, where do you want to end?
- God has already defined your destination, it's left to you to channel your life and move toward it by being obedient to his word.

 - Don't blame your drug addiction on your friends.
 - Don't blame the stagnation of your church on the location.
- Take responsibility for your life and crawl if need be to your destination.
